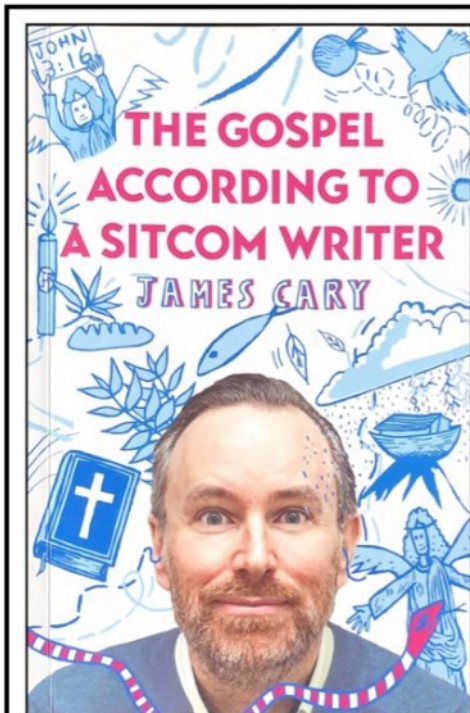
The Mag
