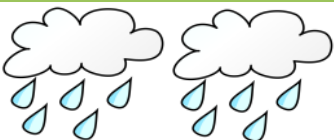

You are warmly invited to join the community at St. Barnabas, as we celebrate the person the church is named after. This coming Sunday 9th June at 6.30 p.m.

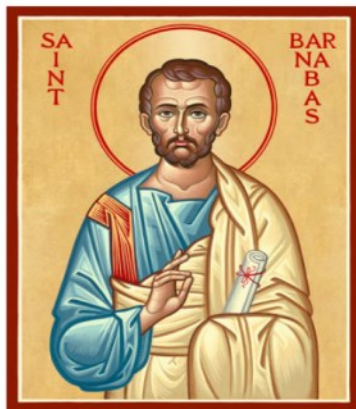
With a special service commemorating St. Barnabas, through songs, readings and a brief reflection on how St Barnabas helps us follow the way of Jesus.
