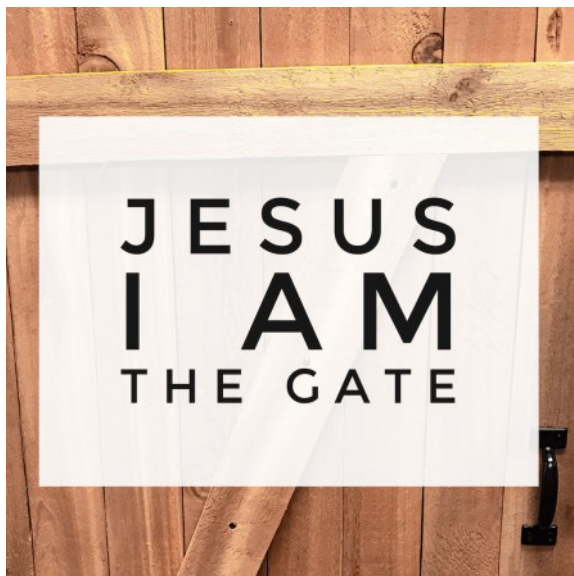

Have a great week. God bless you.

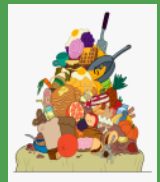
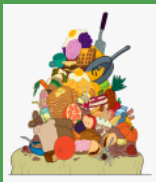
