#### From the Editor .....

I'm an only child so I spent a lot of time on my own when school was not happening. There weren't many children of my age along our street and lots of my school friends didn't live near me. It was not the fashion in the 1950s and 60s to have sleepovers so I never grew up with a close relationship of my own generation. It wasn't until I was 30 that I met my closest friend. She was my daughter's teacher and not long after I became a Christian, she spotted me in a Christian meeting in The Pav. She had been asking the Lord for a Christian mum to help in the classroom to hear readers and she approached me. We soon struck up a friendly relationship and found we had lots of things in common.

I also got to know her husband and when my marriage failed and the vicar at St Barnabas moved on, I needed a Pastor. The Lord told me to come to AFC because this dear friend worshipped there. The rest is history. We became close friends, I and both Gill and Martin. We attended Faith Camp every year for 34 years together, we had days out and lunches and suppers together and with other friends. Some people who didn't know us even asked if we were sisters.

When Martin went to Cambridge to train as a minister Gill and I would supper together every week and when Martin came home at weekends, I was part of his prayer support team who prayed after Sunday services every week.

I started to train as a teacher after working as Welfare Assistant in the school and Martin and I graduated at the same time... he into the ministry and me into the classroom that Gill vacated when they moved to Basildon.

Now we are all retired we still meet up for lunches and have called each other regularly whenever we are both home on Sundays. What a blessing this close relationship has been for me. The Lord has given me a Sister and Brother that I otherwise would not have had. We have shared joys and sadnesses, stresses and laughter. We regularly pray for each other and trust each other with our deepest thoughts.

I was blessed with a Mum who was also a pal. We were very close especially after Dad died at the relatively young age of 67. We were almost inseparable for 34 years until she went to the Lord aged 94. These two close relationships in my life have been very different but such blessings and I praise God that He was so generous to me in them.


